TRAYNOR, JAMES R., Private, Company F, 5th Maryland Infantry, U.S.A. – POW June 15, 1863 Winchester, Virginia – name as shown on gravestone; name also shown as “Trainer” on unit roster, and “Trainor” on service record

WILLIAMS, ELWOOD H., Corporal, Company E, Purnell Legion Maryland Infantry, U.S.A., DOD May 14, 1898

SHARP’S CEMETERY, FAIR HILL – Lewisville Road (Maryland Route 213) southeast of the intersection with Hunt Valley/Grey Fox Drive.

ARMSTRONG, J. RANKIN, *No Service Details*, U.S.A., DOD July 5, 1919 – G.A.R. record, U.C.V. / S.A.N. membership, obituary or other indication of Civil War service does not provide specific unit data – *possibly* Private, Company H, 7th Delaware Infantry

CATHER, FRANCIS E., Private, Company B, 6th Maryland Infantry, U.S.A., DOD September 29, 1906 – unit roster shows name as “Cathers”

CROFT, JAMES, Private, Company E, 4th Delaware Infantry, U.S.A., DOD December 17, 1903

GIBSON, ANDREW A., Private, Company A, 5th United States Artillery

GREEN, JOSHUA, Jr., Corporal, Company C, 1st Delaware Infantry, U.S.A., DOD December 20, 1910 – Post 10 GAR marker

HERLEY, JOHN, Private, Company H, 2nd Maryland Infantry, U.S.A., DOD March 24, 1880 – roster shows name as “Hurley”

JANNEY, E. WESLEY, Private, Company G, 6th Maryland Infantry, U.S.A., DOD August 16, 1890 – name on unit roster shown as “Weshe Janney,” and he served in the 2nd Pennsylvania Cavalry under the name “Westley Jordan” – Post 10 GAR marker – “G.A.R.”

MACKIE, FRANKLIN T., Private, Company B, 6th Maryland Infantry, U.S.A., DOD October 29, 1903 – unit roster and service record also show name recorded as “Franklin Mackey,” “Frederick Makay,” “Frederick Mackey,” “Francis T. Mackee,” and “Francis T. Mackey”

McCRERY, ALBERT T., Private, Company I, 2nd Pennsylvania Heavy Artillery, U.S.A., DOD April 19, 1920

SUTTON, EDWIN, Private, Company E, 38th New Jersey Infantry, U.S.A., DOD May 24, 1917
