**Description of any carvings on stone:** Above the inscription is a large oval  
with a circle centered and resting on the lower edge. This looks something  
like an eye or a rising or setting sun.. Above the oval there are three figures,



they have eyes and may have originally had a nose and mouth. Below each are lines curving out and upwards, that might represent wings or flames.

The figures are onion or flame shaped with rounded tops.

**Cataloguer's remarks:** one of the larger stones in the cemetery, the edges are rounded, and a double channel is carved 2" and 3" in from the edge all around the stone. Broken in three places.
