

The Sharps Cemetery Association met in Rock Session House, Tuesday evening, June 27th, 1972 with ten members present.

In the absence of John Corcoran I conducted the meeting.

The minutes of the last meeting were read, also the treasurers report which was as follows:

Horace Ewing reported that Mrs. Groves wished to have rambler roses planted around the cemetery. It was voted on that we did not want these as it would mean more work to keep them under control.

Louise Spratt made a motion that flowers be permitted in pots and containers on the graves during the summer. It was seconded by Marion Buckingham and voted by the majority. This will mean the men who mow the cemetery will be responsible for moving the flowers and putting them back after they finish. We would like this done even if it means paying a little more.

Joe Mackie suggested the cemetery fence be painted again. It was moved and seconded and approved by the majority.
