She is buying new etching equipment and sourcing stone from Georgia for \$224 per set of four. We need to order one set of M stones and Mary is willing to drive to Middletown to pick them up once they are complete. We will place the order as soon as she is up and running. We will enlist the help of Nathan to install the four sets of stones in need of placement as soon as we receive them.
