

The Sharps Cemetery Association met in Rock Session House, Thursday evening, May 14, 1970 with 11 members present.

The meeting was in charge of John Corcoran who reported the amount of money on hand as follows: \$10,500 in bonds, \$100.00 in savings & \$2,153.23 in checking account. Making a total of \$12,753.23.

An anonymous donor will pay to have the tomb stones straightened up and graves filled in if the association approves. It was moved and seconded to let him have this work done.

A new road is needed through the cemetery and bids are to be gotten to find the cost of black topping it.

A motion was made and seconded that the price be raised from \$3.00 per year to \$5.00 per year dues. The last time the price was raised was in 1954.

The meeting adjourned.
