One bid submitted for grass service for next year from Nathan Brummit. His fee would be \$250 for mowing three times a month and \$125 for trimming which would be done on an as needed basis.

Cooper sent a price increase of \$15 for a burial @\$525 vs \$515 last year. Their charge for cremation open and closing is \$275.

Noted again that we increased our cremation price from \$200 to \$250 with \$150 going to the digger and \$100 to the cemetery fund.

The six sets of cornerstones (4 new and 2 relocated) have been installed by Jerry and Mary. Difficulty was encountered in finding some of the existing cornerstones for proper measurements as they have sunk so far in the ground. Sand was used on the new installs in hopes of slowing down this occurrence. Work will be needed in the spring to raise the old stones.

One contact on the website from John Magaw requesting prices for a double lot and questioning if his grandparents are buried there. Jerry sent the information on the cost of the lots, but needs the name of the grandparents to locate them as there are no existing graves in the Magaw name.

No snow flags needed this year with the installation of the corner posts and chains which look good.
