- **Trash.** It was noted that Eric has been picking up decorations before mowing and placings them in the trash can which is now overflowing. Franklin volunteered to dispose of the trash on Saturday.
- **Corner stones.** Tom reported that the needed corner stones have been ordered but no indication from Abba when they would be available. We still have sets for Long and Mackie that need to be installed.
