• Fence. Approval was granted for Tom McClure to wire brush and paint the fence. He has proposed painting the fence with Direct to Metal oil paint from Benjamin Moore, which he gets for a 15% discount at \$57/gallon. He will wire brush all loose material and apply one coat of paint. After drying he will check it and give a second coat where necessary. He will start when the nighttime temperatures are consistently in the 50's, probably mid-May. Cost of labor is \$1700. He estimates needing 7-8 gallons of paint, plus the cost of wire brushes will be cost about an additional \$500. He will provide receipt from Benjamin Moore.

Sherry from Oxford Cemetery says that he painted their fence 7 years ago and it has held up well and they were pleased with his work.

- Lot sales. Tom sold two adjacent lots, Above the Driveway, Row 35, Lot A & B, to Jonathan DeBusk for \$1850. Only four corner stones are needed.

- Corner stones. Tom will order stones I, G and three sets of D's.
- **Damage.** Tom noticed some mowing damage to several stones including his own. He will speak with Eric to clarify responsibility.
- **Finances**. Portfolio is up \$600 for the year.
